Mr Sternberg addressed the board with concerns of stormwater flooding his basement during high flow events, and inquired as to whether or not future system improvements included upsizing any of the storm drains near his property. The board assured him that the matter would be investigated.

Project Updates

Bjorn updated the board on the status of contract one and contract two of Phase 1. Bacco has installed flume manholes and 30" gate valves. Heikkila mentioned that turf restoration and gravel roads need to be addressed as well as the discharge pipe elevations. BnB plans to start on East cone street in mid July, substantial completion is Aug 5th with LD after that. Heikkila also expressed concerns with turf restoration on the Cedar street site. Bjorn presented a resolution to approve Draw Request 11 in the amount of \$179194.45.

Bjorn presented change order #5 which is the addition of a catch basin on cedar street to address a very flat section of road that did not drain properly, also included in this catch basin was a storm water service for 25855 Cedar street.

Vactor Camera Nozzel
